 - Sample forms or documentation
 - Proof of court-related service delivery
 - Organizational capability statement

- Curriculum product (PDF or access link)
 - Curriculum outline
 - Learning objectives
 - Target audience description
 - Author qualifications or professional bio
 - Two professional references
 - Intended court or educational use
